Congratulations go out to Coach Harvey Hoffman and the volleyball team who qualified for State by winning the region tournament. The team also won the academic award for the region. Great job Halfbreeds. We started the month with a SAC committee meeting to discuss and plan the Veteran's Day event. We had a very successful parent conference event with 85% of the parents visiting the High School, which is the largest number any teacher here can remember coming to the school. Over 300 people came to the Veteran's Day dinner that was sponsored by the General Store and AC Co. Ken Smith was our cooking master and it was a great event. Report cards went home at the start of the month and progress reports went home before Thanksgiving. We hosted a volleyball tournament and had a movie night for our students to celebrate good grades.
