

Superintendent Report Items – Board Meeting September 9, 2020

• Leadership Team

- The Leadership team had a successful New Teacher Orientation and all Staff In-service.
- IT continues to prepare devices for classroom student learning and remote learning.
- COVID Protocols (masks, daily temperature log, cleaning/disinfecting) are still in effect at the DO.

• Construction

- Moving forward, with prep work for the new foundation starting.
- Sewer and water connections have been completed.
- Due to COVID, there are delivery issues, which have resulted in some timeline updates. They are expecting to make up the time changes during the upcoming months; i.e., scheduled completion still on track.

• Maintenance

- School-owned housing in the villages has been an ongoing issue that will require updating of buildings and furniture.
- Lower unit for the Boat motor has not arrived.
- Older Buses are being posted for sale soon.
- Prompt action continues to improve with work orders

• Other Items

- Due to COVID distancing, each school has need of additional classroom furniture and some of the schools need replacement items.
- All schools reported a good first two days of classes.
- Due to an active COVID case in Aniak and subsequent travel, all schools in KSD went to “High” status. Schools are either on total lockdown or remote learning with packet delivery.
- Due to “Shelter in Place” orders in 3 communities, schools were not allowed to deliver computers or paper packets. In those villages, there will need to be an action plan for how the missed student contact days will be made up.
- IT has requested SERCC monitoring for eRate. This will enable IT personnel to focus on direct site needs for IT.
