For the past 3 weeks since the last board report, the Upriver schools have had a few things going on. We've certainly had our share of travel obstructed by weather.

The JJSS Science Fair was held on Feb 5-6. Due to weather, JESS was not able to attend. The fair had to be extended through Saturday, 8 Feb when we were finally able to get all of our student participants home.

With JJSS being designated a CSI (Comprehensive Support Intervention) school, Pat McDonald from SSOS (State System of Support Coaching Program) has been working with the JJSS staff, Emily and myself to develop an RTI program to improve math and reading programs at JJSS in particular as well as improve overall district math and reading programs. Pat helped set up STEPP programs at each of the four upriver schools as well.

Feb 26-27, Holly Hill with NAEP (National Assessment of Educational Progress) has been at CVSS and JESS respectively administering national assessments for student data on math and reading. NAEP, known as the nation's report card, has been testing 4<sup>th</sup> graders at the two schools.

NYCP (Native Youth Community Projects) continues to grow in the upriver schools with monthly activities.

WIDA testing is continuing this month and will conclude before Spring Break.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter is nearing its end. Grades will be out and Spring PTCs will be held shortly after staff and students return from the break.

The Upriver Basketball Tournament will be held at JESS March 6-7. Students from all three schools will be attending.
