Federal Programs

CRRSA II Funds

Funds were received and loaded into the GMS budget planning tool. The funds may be used for:

- Preparing schools for reopening

- Improvements in indoor air

Summer Camp 2021

KSD Leadership intends to use CRRSA II funds to address potential learning loss as a result of school closures during the COVID-19 pandemic. KSD will be offering a summer camp with cultural and academic activities.

Students who were in **preschool through 3rd grade during the 2020-2021 school year** will have the opportunity to attend camp at participating schools.

Students who were in **4th through 12th grade during the 2020-2021 school year** will have the opportunity to attend camp at Caunaq (Kalskag's Culture Camp). KSD will provide transportation to and from the home villages and Caunaq.

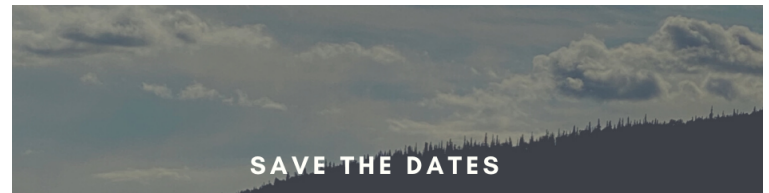
- Session 1: June 14-June 30
