A Resolution of the Kuspuk School District Board of Education for District Ownership of
Buildings & Improvements

WHEREAS, AS 14.08.101 (8) and AS 14.08.151 (b) gives legal authority to regional school boards to request and to receive ownership of all land and buildings used in relation to regional educational attendance area schools; and

WHEREAS, such ownership would give the regional school board greater flexibility and improved management of its facilities; and

WHEREAS, control of the buildings and lands by the regional school board would have a positive effect on community attitudes and involvement in the schools;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to AS 14.08.101 (8) and AS 14.08.151 (b), the Kuspuk School District Board of Education respectfully requests of the Commissioner of Education & Early Development, title to the school facilities and improvements in the community of Kalskag.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the said title to the above properties be delivered to the Kuspuk School District Board of Education with deliberate haste.
