



Superintendent Report — October 31, 2016

President Morgan, Board Members and others in attendance, I would like to highlight the following items as part of my report.

FY 17 Staffing: We are still currently seeking a second teacher in Stony River. We have been considering an applicant who is getting her initial certificate into place.

Enrollment: The DO Admin team has been working on the Fall Oasis Report which is the report that determines count during October. If no discrepancies show up we are looking at the numbers to the right... This is in line with our projection last year of 345. We did however build a budget based on 331 students to ensure we are within our budgetary means in case our enrollment dropped. This year I submitted the FY2018 count to be 355.

Kuspuk Board of Directors Scholarship. As of the writing of this report, there was 1 submissions for the KSD Board of Directors Scholarship by the November 25th deadline. I did put the word out to all of the graduates that
