EXCEL Programs in March 2018

There are several programs for high school students that have been going on the past few weeks.



Through EXCEL Alaska, on the grounds of NIT in Palmer, students participated in the NIT Boot Camp where students received a 10 day training in various aspects of Heavy Equipment Operations. This program was mainly open to junior and seniors. Five Kuspuk Students participated in this program.

In addition to the Industry Bootcamp, Drivers Ed training also went on in Palmer at the NIT drivers school. There students received several hours of driving experience as well as the opportunity to receive a license. Five Kuspuk students participated in this program.

The last EXCEL Alaska program that students could participate in was the Introduction to the Aviation Session. For students to participate in this program they need to also commit to ground school and flight hours this summer. This 10 day session gave our students experiences in what to expect when committing to a career in aviation. Dave LeMaster, former AJSHS teacher, signed on to lead instruction in this event. Four of our Kuspuk students participated in this program.
