Note: The following optional policy may be revised to reflect district philosophy and needs.

The district shall purchase equipment, supplies and services on a competitive bidding basis when required by law and whenever it appears to be in the best interest of the district to do so. The Superintendent or designee shall establish procedures to insure that verbal quotes are obtained for purchases over \$500 \$4,000.00, that informal written quotes are obtained for purchases between \$2,000 and \$25,000, and that formal advertised bids are solicited for purchases over \$25,000.

To ensure that good value is received for funds expended, specifications shall be carefully designed and shall describe in detail the quality, delivery and service required.

All bids under Federal awards must be made in accordance with the standards set forth in 2 CFR 200.320.
