EXCEL Alaska CTE Construction / Welding Camp 2017

We had a total of 22 participants complete the CTE Construction / Welding Camp. Students had to choose either carpentry or welding, but all students became NCCER Core certified. One group

learned carpentry fundamentals while building projects such as a 12 x 8 steam bath house, a dog house and 16 x 20 shed. We had 3 Aniak students, 4 Kalskag students, 1 Marshall Student, 1 Nunam Iqua student, 4 Bethel students, 2 Alakanuk students, 1 Kotlik student, 2 Hooper Bay students, 2 Manley Hot Springs students, 1 Nulato student, 1 Minto student, and 2 Scammon Bay students.

Of these 22 students all became NCCER Core certified. Core certification consists of 9 modules with a test in each showing proficiency in Basic Safety, Construction Mathematics, Hand Tool use, Power Tool use, Construction Drawings, Basic Rigging, Communication Skills, Employability Skills and Materials Handling.

These students also completed work on their Personal Learning and Career Plans. In this part of the



program students explored careers, completed interest inventories, work preferences, various training programs. Each student had to present their career of choice to an audience while at the camp.
