Distance Delivery For Sped Students

SPED teacher and principal collaborated and worked with general education teachers on best practices for implementing accommodations for academic work being sent home. Academic work as been accommodated as applicable before sending home. SPED teacher provided strategies to family members on how to implement accommodations at home. SPED teacher will call students, as applicable, to work on speech goals and objectives. SPED teacher will review OT reports, and/or contact OT by email for support and suggestions as applicable. Specific plans for intensive needs students are being addressed by SPED teacher and the student's aide in collaboration with families.

Distant Delivery For Students

Teachers created work packets to send home to their students. English Language Arts, Math, Socials Studies and Science. The bus driver delivered these packets. Teachers and Classified aides check in with students by phone twice a week. Teachers work from home only going into the school one day a week. Scheduled phone calls with the State System of Support coach to cover RTI data from the 3rd quarter and any ideas moving forward. Teachers completed their Curriculum Inventory needs for the 2020-2021. We are working out some technology situations that would provide Internet to some of the village. At this time we will not be accepting work in a paper copy, if students have the ability to submit work through email or messenger we will accept that. Teachers will go over work over the phone when check in calls.

Food Deliver

At this time we are waiting for the prepackaged meals to arrive. Once that happens we will divide the food up by student. Each household will be packaged in a separate package and delivered.
