Our first order of business this fiscal year has been our USAC Audit covering our 2015 ERATE funds. Mike and Marge did a fantastic job prior to me arriving organizing and communications with KPMG the initial kickoff documents and information. Thusly setting the tone of our audit which to date is going well. Superintendent and myself meet telephonically with our audit team weekly.

Secondly on September 25th our district received notification of our Alaska School Broadband Grant Agreement or BAG funding. We were awarded \$408,810.12 in broadband assistance to help us supplement our internet connections.
